Remote access is available with both the Zone10e, e-zone, MyAir5 & MyLights products, it utilises your Wi-Fi equipped router to operate. Your modem will require UDP and UPnP to be enabled as well as a strong Wi-Fi connection between the router and your wall mounted touch screen panel.
